into Spain. & Germany & Brazil where  
cane didn't flourish for better than in any  
other of West Indies Is. better even than in  
Spain. For a long time first of European  
sugar was derived from St Domingo. The  
whole of Hispaniola was nominally Spanish till  
1690 but, in 1697 peace of Ryswick western part  
of Is. was retained by Fr. by tacit understanding  
this part had been inhabited by Fr. by chancery  
from middle of 17<sup>th</sup> ct. on. This was most  
unimportant colonial possession of Fr. from  
middle of 18<sup>th</sup> ct. It declared itself independent in  
1791, wh. Fr. proclaimed deth. of King it didn't become  
conquered & Fr. withdrawn from Is in 1803. The  
Spanish part of Is became independent in 1821. Since  
then has followed every sort of paper coalition  
parts have been joined separated, been republics  
empire etc. Sugar prod<sup>ct</sup> suffered in imports  
Island has gone down hill till its internal condition is a
