I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 4<sup>th</sup> instant, enclosing voucher No 10272<sup>a</sup>, in favor of Mr. Thos. H. Andrews, amounting to \$145<sup>00</sup>, for 14½ tons of hay, purchased by the Principal of the St. Joseph's Industrial School, owing to the supply becoming exhausted at the school; and in reply, I have to inform you that this voucher cannot be paid at present. It is inexplicable how such a shortage as 14½ tons of hay could have occurred so suddenly as to make it impossible to obtain authority for the purchase; and
