Sir,-

I am sending you, under separate cover, two copies of the plans and specifications for the erection of a school building on the Whitefish Lake Reserve, revised as recommended by you in respect to the foundation and flooring of the cellar.

I have to ask you to be good enough to send one ~~extra~~ copy of the plans and specifications to the Post Master at Little Current and at the same time notify in writing any contractors who you think might wish to tender and inform them that they may see these plans at the office of Mr. John Young. The tenders are returnable here up to noon of May 29th, so that you will that it will be necessary to lose no time in getting into touch with any probable tenderers. Each tender must be accompanied by an accepted cheque on a chartered bank for ten per cent of the amount of the tender, made payable to the order of the secretary of the Department. The cheque of the successful tenderer will be held by the Department as security for the due fulfillment of the work. You might at the same time give these contractors to whom you have made reference any information as to the site, etc., that you may think necessary.
