

Ottawa, January 3, 1914.

Dear Sir,-

In regard to the appointment of a medical man to attend the Indians from Spuzzum to Spence's Bridge and from Lytton to Foster's Bar to within 20 miles of Lillooet, and also to attend the Indian industrial school, I beg to state that I engaged Dr. Ross for this service. It is now the intention to terminate the previous arrangement with the Mission whereby they co-operated with the Department in the medical service. If Dr. Baines returns or if the Mission is successful in engaging a qualified medical practitioner to attend these Indians, the Department would be disposed to revert to the system in operation before Dr. Ross's appointment.
