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We are confident that the Finnish, Hungarian and Roumanian residents of Canada will continue to play their full part in the present struggle. Free men everywhere have had to choose between subservience and opposition to the totalitarian challenge. The peoples now living in Finland, Hungary and Roumania are clearly under Nazi control. They can resist only passively at the present time, since their actions are circumscribed by the firing squad and the concentration camp. In Canada, the maintenance of freedom of thought and action represents one of the chief moral issues for which we are fighting. There are the strongest of reasons why, as loyal residents of Canada, citizens of Finnish, Hungarian and Roumanian origin should continue to contribute in fullest measure to the war effort of our country.
