Yes, sir. A-225

Would you look at the accused, do you recognize him? 0-226

Yes, sir. A-226

Who is he? 0.-227

Trooper Adams, C.P. A-227

In the course of your investigation did you have anything 2-228 to do with the accused?

Sir, on the morning of the 16th of January, 1943, while investigating the theft of money I came upon the accused in bed. I had him awakened

In what hut? 0-229

A-229 E. 23 F.

Is that his usual barracks?

A-230 Yes, sir, E. 23 F. I had him awakened and I told him I would search his kit and asked him where it was. He showed me and I then dumped the contents of the bag on the floor and commenced to search through it.

Did he get out of bed? 2-231

No, sir, he stayed there. A-231

Q-232 Did he have no objection?

No, sir. While searching through it I found some money A-232 in a pair of socks.

In a pair of socks? Q-233

Yes, sir. A-233

Do you remember the denominations of the bills? 2-234

Yes, sir. Two tens, a five and a one. I again asked Trooper Adams if this was his kit and he said yes. I asked him where the money came from and he said he did not know. I had him placed under close arrest.
