This was the only representative of the brown algae and occurred in smal quantity at Cape Bathurst, July, 1946.

HELMINTHOCLADIACEAE.

Batrachospermum Roth.

Batrachospermum vagum (Roth) Ag.

This species is well known from the fresh waters of nearly all temperate and tropical countries, and a form has been recorded previously from southern Alaska. It was secured by the expedition only from a tundra pond at Telle along with *Hyalotheca mucosa* and other algae. Cystocarps absent. It is one of the earliest known freshwater algae of Canada and was recorded by Kempin 1858, Paris, Canada West (Ontario).
