- ML. In case of the death or insanity of any member, his legatee or legal representative shall have becoming entitled to the privileges of an original shareholder procure his place of abode, and the particulars of his title, to be registered in the books of the Society, or in default thereof for one month shall pay a fine of fifty cents, and shall at the same time exhibit the will or probate thereof, or grant of letters of administration, or other document, (as the case may be) for the inspection and satisfaction of the Directors, and have for such Registry fifty cents in the discretion of the Directors.
- XLI. The Directors shall have power, from time to time, to determine the fees and travelling expenses to be allowed the Inspectors, and the salary and contingences of the Secretary and Treasurer.
- XLII. The Directors elected at the formation of the Society as well as those thereafter to be elected, shall be indennified out of the of the Society, or otherwise, from all expensions are elected the formation, conduct, and management of the Society.
- XLIII. The Directors may make such arrangement with any of the Chartered Banks doing business the Town of Brockville, for the deposit of moneys securities belonging to the Society, and other manciage oncerns, as they shall from time to time deem necessary.
- XLIV. The Directors shall have power to release any existing mortgage upon receiving in lieu thereof another sufficient security, all expenses to be paid by the mortgagor.
- XLV. In the practical application of these rules or any rules to be hereafter made, in virtue thereof, the construction put upon them by the Board of Di-
