- 1. Visiting Directors for the week to have special charge of the institution.
- 2. Directors not to admit persons of improper character, nor those coming from places beyond the city limits, unless provision is made for payment of the board of such persons at the rate of \$1 per week. Destitute travellers requiring a day or two's refuge are exceptions to the foregoing rule.
- 3. Tickets for admission not received at the institution after 5 P.M. in winter, and 7 P.M. in summer.
- 4. Supplies of every kind required for the institution must be first authorised at the regular monthly meetings of the board of directors.
