our faid Lord the King; and they the faid Charles Renault, Jean Baptifle Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard are feverally committed to the faid gaol there to remain for the space of three weeks.

Mr. Attorney General then moved to refolve, feconded by Mr. Lees, that it appearing to this Houfe by the faid record that Charles Baptifte Bouc, Efquire, a member of this Houfe, upon the indictment in the Court of King's Bench for the diftrict of Montreal in this Province, exhibited against him, hath been convicted of the crime of confpiracy with fundry other perfons unjustly and fraudulently to obtain of Etienne Drouin divers large fums of money, the faid Charles Baptifle Bouc be expelled this Houfe.

Mr. Papineau moved, feconded by Mr. Grant, that the further confideration of the motion now before the House be postponed to Wednesday next.
