BY HIS HONOR  
ALEXANDER CROKE,

**W**HEREAS, the Writs issued for calling the General Assembly, and which bear test the 17th of August last, are made returnable at Halifax, on Thursday the 10th day of October:—

And Whereas the attendance of the Members chosen, or to be chosen, for the respective Counties and Towns within the Province, is not required on the said 10th day of October:—

I have thought fit to prorogue the meeting of the General Assembly until Thursday the 12th day of December next, and all Sheriffs, and others who it may concern, are required to take notice, and govern themselves accordingly.

GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, at Halifax, this 20th day of September, 1811, in the 51st year of His Majesty's Reign.

BY HIS EXCELLENCY LIEUTENANT-GENERAL  
Sir JOHN COAPE SHERBROOKE,

*Knight of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Lieutenant-Governor and Commander  
in Chief, in and over His Majesty's Province of Nova-Scotia, and its Dependencies,  
&c. &c. &c.*

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Province stands prorogued to Thursday, the 12th day of December next:—

I have thought fit, further to prorogue the said General Assembly, until Thursday the 6th day of February, 1812, then to meet for the Dispatch of Business, of which all persons concerned, are desired to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
