at *Charlottetown*, the Twenty-second Day of
January, Anno Domini 1839, in the Second

VICTORIA, by the Grace of God of the
United Kingdom of *Great Britain and Ire-*
land, Queen, Defender of the Faith:

Fifteenth General Assembly convened in the said

CAP. I.

An Act to confirm and render valid certain pro-
ceedings of the Executive Government of this
Island.

[Passed January 31st, 1842.]

WHEREAS by Her Majesty's Royal Com-
mission, in the absence of the Governor,
Lieutenant Governor, or other Officer specially
appointed to Administer the Government of this
Island, the Government thereof vests in the Senior
Military Officer for the time being, within the said
Island: And whereas in consequence of the small-
ness of the Military force quartered in the said
Island; the Commandant thereof is not a Field
