We recognize that Mr. Temple may reply by saying he simply means that he will have more influence with the government than Mr. Gregory. That is just what remains to be proved. If Mr. Temple is worth anything Mr. Temple will have no influence, from a party standpoint, with the government as the next parliament. He would have little influence, and no necessity to buy up newspapers or constituencies. The full subsidy ought to have been got when the subsidies were going, that is if it was to be got from the government. With a liberal government Mr. Temple would have very little influence, or at least not nearly so much as Mr. Gregory would have.

In the event of the liberals coming in power, which appears to be almost beyond a question, the promoters of the Woodstock and Fredericton railway will have, if Mr. Gregory is elected, the influence of the liberal member for Carlton and the liberal member for this constituency.

RAILWAY HORROR.

Frightful Railroad Disaster in Vermont.

Plunged Over a Bridge Sixty Feet Into the River Below.

Flames Add to the Horror—The Dead and Dying.

BRANDFORD, Vermont, Feb. 5.—The night express which left White River Junction, this morning, for Montreal, was wrecked on the bridge over the river below. The cars immediately took fire and within ten minutes were all consumed, as was also the bridge. The loss of life is estimated at fifty, and the number of injured is large. The rescuers met with great obstacles. The train was on the bridge, about 2 o'clock this morning. The engine, baggage, two passenger cars and two sleepers plunged over the bridge, sixty feet into the river below. The cars immediately took fire and within ten minutes were all consumed, as was also the bridge. The loss of life is estimated at fifty, and the number of injured is large. The rescuers met with great obstacles.

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including trainmen, was a catastrophe which 32 are accounted for, and about 38 in the care of surgeons, wounded, one of which died, and a nine-year-old boy along on the same train as the injured trainmen, only four unaccounted for. It is understood that there were several children without tickets which may explain the above figures.

Every article of clothing, scrap of paper or other thing which may have been upon any passenger is being carefully saved and written up for the purpose of identification, and parties having friends unaccounted for will be afforded every means or clue to the identification of lost or unknown.

At the time of the accident, and ever since, the thermometer has registered 4 to 45 degrees below zero, and the

SUFFERING FROM GOLD WATERS.

There are only thirty-three houses in the town of Water River, and the houses are filled with wounded. The others are scattered along for three or four miles with no means of communication except by train. All the road officials are on the ground and everything possible is being done for the wounded and dead. Hundreds of people searching for friends are here, and nearly every newspaper in New England has a representative at the scene of the wreck. Work was suspended at six o'clock on the 4th inst. owing to the severity of the weather, but resumed this morning. The water in White River, at the place of the accident, has been so high that it is impossible to get across the river by the usual route. The water is about 14 feet high, and the ice is about 14 feet thick. The falling of the cars upon the bridge, and the subsequent fire, have not sufficiently let portions of the wreck fall through.
