Canadian Fire Patrol Ship Reaches Port.

Built at a Cost of \$12,000—The Best Equipped Boat for Her Size That Ever Crossed the Atlantic.

At 6 o'clock this morning the Canadian fire patrol ship Laval, Capt. Dillon, bound from Middleborough, England, to Quebec, put into this port short of coal. She is a new vessel and was launched only two months ago. She was built at Middleborough, by the Smith Dry Dock Co., to the order of the Quebec Harbour Commissioners at a cost to the Canadian Government of over twelve thousand pounds sterling. She was designed by John Reid & Co., naval architects, of Montreal, and is specially constructed and fitted with all the latest and up-to-date appliances for the work she is intended to do.

Though not the size of a leviathan, the Laval is one of the most modern and best equipped boats that ever crossed the Atlantic. However, she has a most deceptive appearance to look at her from the outside, and the casual observer could scarcely imagine what her installations are like. The ship was berthed at A. J. Harvey & Co's, pier this morning, where crowds of people visited her and were shown through by the courteous and obliging officers on board, and all were agreeably surprised with what they saw.

It is strange to say that although the Laval has a carrying capacity of 123 tons, her interior from stem to stern, including engine room, accommodation, etc., would do credit to the most palatial Atlantic liners. She is constructed of steel, armour plated fore and aft with an ice-breaking bow. Extending all round the ship is a wooden and iron plated guard. The ship is extensively supplied with fire protectors such as hose, pump and water, and can quench a fire effectively, no matter how great and at the shortest notice. The engine room is situated amidships. The engine is of the latest and most improved make and is a thousand horse power. Over the engine room are three huge casks containing fresh water for use on board; nearby is a huge pump which can be used in cases of emergency. The pump operates automatically from the engine room. It is very powerful and can throw water and quench fire two hundred yards distant. To illustrate this, and so great is the water pressure, Chief Officer Lilly of the ship told us that lying at Harvey's pier the pump could control a fire at the Lighthouse. The captain's bridge is situated forward and contains a thirty thousand candle power electric searchlight. The ship is fitted throughout with electricity.

Aft of the bridge is the saloon, which contains a beautifully finished oak extension table and chairs capable of accommodating about 20 persons. Adjoining the saloon is the galley or cook house, which is also conveniently attached to the kitchen. Below the deck are the staterooms and officers' quarters, all of which are elaborately decorated and furnished and fitted with the most modern improvements. A noteworthy feature is the provision made for the stokers and sailors. They have their quarters aft and are splendidly arranged and supplied with tables, hot and cold water baths and clothes closets.

The Laval made 14 knots on her trial spin. On the passage from Middleborough the ship behaved splendidly, notwithstanding the rough weather encountered, and proved herself an excellent seaboat. In other respects she is perfection itself and no doubt will suit the requirements of the Canadian Government.

She took on board 12 tons of coal this morning to last her to Sydney, where she left for to-day to replenish her supply and then proceed to her destination and be delivered to her new owners. The Laval can be utilized as a towing boat, fire boat, ice-breaker, patrol boat or even a yacht. She has a powerful towing winch near the stern and can tow almost anything afloat.
