### OCCOCCOCCOCCO Paint and Paint Mixing.

Editor Evening Telegram,

Dear Sir:-On the high interest founds in reading Canon Lockyer's articles on Trinity, I had long ago promised to write him of my own experience with paint mixed with sea-water and other things of a like nature. Now I have decided to write the Telegram

Canon Lockyer is quite right about the mixability of paint with seawater. I have been doing this occasionally for the past twenty years and making comparisons with other nixtures from time to time I find that paint so mixed has very little, if any, advantage with regards to durability over other paints. If there is any difference it is to be found in the paints applied since the war. This might be easily explained by the fact that we have drifted past the days of genuine linseed-oil into the period of make shift where anything is sold as such that gives off even a counterfeit odor

of the genuine article. With regards however, to the weather-resisting qualities of any paint, there are different things to consider. First of all, it can be taken as certain that a house painted after a wet spell will become shabby looking much easier than if it were painted after a fine spell of sunshine because it absorbs much easier and therefore retains the ingredients of the paint much longer At the same time to be fully competent to judge which is the better mixture it is quite necessary to understand the kind of lumber you have painted. In many cases of building in those later years, on account of the old mature trees being depleted, especially umber than formerly and I think most veryone knows that sap is as repulsive to paint as a rotten egg to an epicure. The fact remains, however that sea-water will give you more paint without impairing its efficiency Cod oil will do the same thing with added advantage, but better still is the mixture of two thirds of ready mixed (I refer only to "Matchless" white ! have tried no other) paint to one third of white lead mixed with oil from the livers of dog-fish. This also thickens very much after mixing and the further use of this oil for the purpose of thinning increases its preserving qualities. If dog-fish oil is drawn as it comes from the liver it is pract-
