LIBERTY IN ONTARIO.

From the report of the inspector of prisons and public charities on the asylums of the province, which has just been issued, we learn that the number of persons of unsound mind in the five asylums of the province on September 30, 1927, was 2742.

Two important facts may be inferred from the information contained in the report. One is that the curability of insane patients almost entirely depends upon their being placed under treatment while the disease is yet in its incipient stages.

The question of whether insanity is increasing more rapidly in this province than the general population is a difficult one to answer.
