This is a big improvement, and will bring out a big exhibit next year. The fancy is picking up in Newmarket. Mr. Geo. Davison, an old-time fancier, has just come to life, and bought a fine bunch of black Minorcas, Abbot strain. There is quite a rivalry as to who will have the finest Pekin ducks next show.
