BAVARIA.—A new 3pf. band printed in green has been issued.

BELGIUM.—The following three stamps have appeared. 20 centimes, gray; 50 centimes, violet; 2 franc, violet.

Canada. $\frac{1}{4}$ lb. cigarette stamps black and blue have just been issued.

CEYLON.—Postal cards of 5 and 10 cents.

CHILI.—A 2 centavos card, blue on orange card.

CHINA.—A new set, similar to old one, values same but smaller.

FINLAND.—A 5 marks, green and red and a 10 marks, brown and red have been issued.

Holkar. $\frac{1}{4}$ anna mauve.

LIBERIA.—Stamps of a new design have appeared, values are: 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 16 and 32 cents.

Monaco. 1 ct bands and 5 and 15 ct envelopes.

MOZAMBIQUE.—This colony has a new series of stamps, values and colors:
