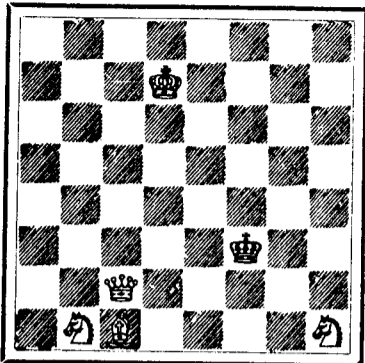

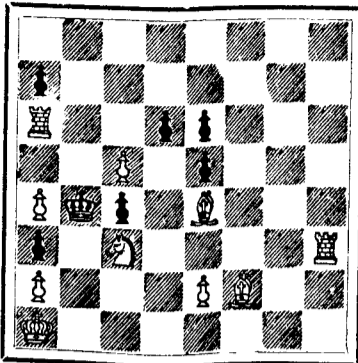

- White. 1. Q-B 7. 2. Q x K P +. 3. Kt-Q 4 mate. Black. K-K 3. R x Q. If 1. R x B. K-B 5.

No. 404.

In this problem there should be a black Knight on Black Q Kt 3, instead of a White Knight.
