

- Chile's labor force is rather well educated by Latin American standards. Most of those with no education are found in the rural areas where the illiteracy rate is 21.9%. The proportion of persons 14 years old and over with at least a high school degree is over 70%, and 27% have completed special and higher education in the Santiago Metropolitan area.
- During 1991, students attending the University amounted to 146,720, while in professional 6. institutes there were 37,376 and in polytechnical centers, 65,987. There are 23 state universities, 44 private universities, 2 professional institutes and numerous polytechnic centers and professional institutes which operate without state support.
