INTERNATIONAL NEGOTIATIONS AND AGREEMENTS

Agreements concluded:

1. Multilateral: Agreement between Canada, France, Iceland, Netherlands and the United Kingdom concerning the operation of the Icelandic Station of the Northeast Loran Chain. Signed at Montreal, April 30, 1947.
2. Canada-United States: Exchange of Notes providing for the renewal of arrangements for the exchange of Agricultural Labour and Farm Machinery. Signed at Ottawa, April 24 and May 19, 1947.
3. Canada-China: Supplementary Financial Agreement. Signed at Ottawa, May 28, 1947.
