Those who understand this last subject technically will say at once that we must accept Ontario and other provincial certificates and that therefore we cannot refuse a Quebec certificate and therefore our matriculation could not stand. This is not so. If our own matriculation governs all scholarships and all honours and shews the path of preferment, prospective students will take it. Common sense and the advice of their schoolmasters will urge them to do it. We must of course accept the Quebec certificate as also the Ontario one as a protanto method of entry to the pass school. But we would do the same for a certificate from Timbuctoo or for the students from the Mosque of El Ashar at Cairo.

I desire also to call attention to one last consideration, in its true meaning first in importance. It is a matter again of the spirit, and not of the rule, of the inner light and not of the organization of a
