#### **ARTIFICIAL TEETH,**

Double sets on gold, made in the new atmospheric-pressure principle, without springs, perfectly comfortable, and nearly as useful for articulation and mastication as natural teeth—price, with gums, twenty-five pounds, without, twenty pounds; upper set, with gums, fifteen pounds, without, twelve pounds ten shillings. Partial sets on gold plate with or without clasps, single tooth two pounds ten shillings; three or four five pounds; several, seven pounds ten shillings. For partial sets stumps may not be extracted if sound and healthy. Silver plates gilt about half price, but not recommended.

#### **PIVOT TEETH,**

Set on stumps with compressed wooden pivots, or hollow gold pivots and tube with a spring to remove at pleasure, from fifteen to twenty shillings.

#### **TEETH PLUGGED**

As circumstances may require, with Adhesive Gold, common Gold Foil, Tin Foil or Cement, from Five to Ten Shillings.

#### **TEETH EXTRACTED**

With Forceps of the latest and best description, adapted to the form of each tooth, when used with a strong and experienced hand the least possible pain is endured,—charge, 2s. 6d.  
Chloroform or Electricity used if required.

DENTISTRY, from the necessarily very limited knowledge persons in general possess of it, is more liable to imposition than any other profession, there is no other occupation that requires more experience, mechanical ingenuity, integrity, and sound judgment, yet we constantly see attempts, by inexperienced hands, at making plate-work resulting in teeth altogether different from what they should be, and teeth plugged that are totally inadequate for the purpose intended. It is a masterpiece of Dental art, possessed by few persons, to make a full set of teeth without springs, to fit comfortably, look beautifully, and masticate properly.
