the Forces who is unable to secure such employment as will yield sufficient remuneration to provide for himself and his dependents or for whom such employment cannot be secured by reason of there being no employment avail—able as certified by the Representative of the Department of Soldiers' Civil Re-Establishment as per clause 11 thereof. It shall be deemed also to include the case of an ex-member of the Forces for whom employment can be found but at a rate of remuneration insufficient for him to provide for himself and his dependents, provided that the amount of any assistance granted in such case shall with the earnings of the applicant, not exceed the minimum amount which might be granted under the regulations to an ex-member of the Force who is unable to secure employment of any kind;

(19) That the Canadian Patriotic Fund shall prepare such rules and regulations as may be deemed necessary, setting forth clearly and definitely the conditions under which financial assistance shall be given in accordance with this Order in Council, and the maximum amount of such financial assistance, provided that before the issue of such regulations they shall be submitted to the Minister of Soldiers' Civil Re-Establishment for his concurrence and subsequently to the Governor General in Council for approval; provided also that, with the concurrence of the Governor General in Council, such regulations may be changed from time to time.
