Persons desiring to send such matter to soldiers serving in France and elsewhere should securely pack the contents in wooden boxes or cartons made of strong material and place sufficient absorbing material in the receptacle so that in the event of breakage liquids will not ooze thru the box and damage other articles of mail. If this precaution was taken the postoffice as well as the sender would be saved considerable trouble and expense and often unnecessary inconvenience.
