

Promenade on Dufferin Terrace

Formerly called Durham Terrace, is the pride of the people of Quebec. It is the finest promenade on the continent. It extends along the brow of Cape Diamond for over one-fourth of a mile under the shadow of the citadel and over two hundred feet above the river. It is about sixty feet wide and provided with comfortable seats. A handsome railing in front. During the administration of Lord Dufferin, it was very much improved and the name changed in honor of bim. The great elevation affords a grand view over Lower Town across the river to Levis, and as far down as the eye can reach.
