country is largely what the Church under God will make it. Let the minister, the missicuary, magnify his office. Let no man take his crown. In this utilitarian day some man may say that the minister is producing nothing tangible, and therefore has no place in our social system. But if under the blessing of the Spirit he produces character he is making the most tremendous contribution to the country's welfare and influence. John Knox never made a plough or built a railway, but by the grace of God he made a nation, and that nation has done its good share in the making of a better world. So may it be with every missionary in Canada.
