## HOCKEY MAGNATES GETTING READY

Fouls Defined at Special Meeting of N. H. A.—Inter-League Agreement.

The National Hockey Association held a very lengthy meeting at the King Edward Hotel Saturday.

Those who expected a very exciting session were somewhat disappointed, as the principal discussion was in connection with the alteration of some of the playing rules.

Full rules laid down are as follows:

1. The referee has the right to overrule an umpire's decision in the case of a disputed goal.

2. Players may be changed at any time during the game.

3. Coaching thru a megaphone will not be allowed.

4. Minor, major and match fouls were defined and the penalties for same were decided upon.

5. A minor foul consists of holding an opponent or his stick, also tripping when a goal is not in danger. Loafing offside is also a minor foul.

6. A player who makes a minor foul is to be warned once for each offence, and for a repetition of this offence he is to be fined \$2, with the exception of loafing offside, in which case the fine is \$5.

7. A player who commits a major foul is to be treated as such.

8. Cross-checking, charging from behind, kicking, cutting, throwing sticks to prevent a score, tripping an opponent, stopping a goal by intentionally knocking or lying on the ice, and abusive language to any of the officials, constitutes a major foul.

9. The penalty will be a fine of \$5 for the first offence, for the second offence an additional fine of \$10 and suspension from play for 20 minutes; for the third offence an additional fine of \$25 and suspension from play for the rest of the game.

10. A match foul consists of deliberately disabling an opponent.

11. A player who offends in this matter will be fined \$25 and be banished from the game for such time as he is required to be in the hospital to return to play, unless the offence is the second or third, in which case the penalty for the major foul will be imposed.

12. E. C. Quinn was instructed to complete his negotiations with the Maritime League and form a working commission between the two associations.

13. "Ciccone" Taylor has gone to the United States and will return to Port Arthur, Ont., in a few days.
