

SITUATION IS MOST DIFFICULT

Hythe, England, Aug. 9.—When Premiers Millerand and Lloyd George met here today to discuss the situation, their conference here over the Russo-Polish situation they had before them was the decisive meeting of Marshal Poch and Field Marshal Wilson, dealing with the extent of the military, naval and air aid that France and England can give immediately to

Having decided that actual war should not be waged on Russia, the premier was confronted with a most difficult problem. It is his duty to decide to give Poland every aid within the limit of this decision. In both French and English papers, the word "defensive" is emphasized in connection with all the proposed aid. The British government, however, England want it distinctly understood that the aid is for a complete line of measures against Russia.
