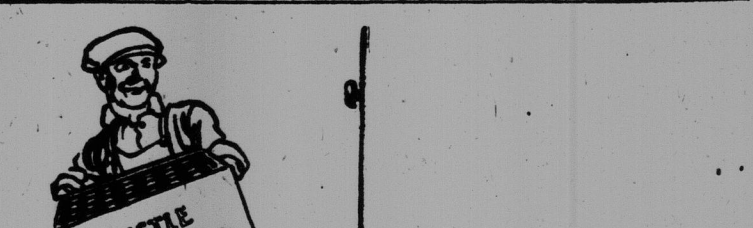

**Inspect Site Of Memorial Hall**

F. Neil Brodie, of St. John, has been chosen as the architect for the War Memorial building to be erected at the University of New Brunswick. The site was inspected on Saturday by a party of those interested and it was decided that the building should be erected east of the Arts building and observatory.

Lord Byng, of Vimy Governor-General, is to be asked to lay the cornerstone during his official visit in July. The cost is to be \$125,000 of which \$25,000 is contributed by the city of Fredericton and \$100,000 by the province of New Brunswick. It is not expected that building will be completed by the opening of Academic year in September but it is likely that the building will be in use during the year. The departments of chemistry and physics will have class rooms and laboratories in the new building and convocation hall which will accommodate 600 people also will be there. Those who were present during the inspection were Dr. W. S. Carter, Dr. W. C. Crockett, Mr. Justice Crockett, H. H. Hagerman, C. D. Richards, Mr. P. J. Baird, Miss Elizabeth Hunter, A. S. McFarlane.

The building committee is composed of Chancellor Jones, Col. Murray MacLaren, C. M. G., of St. John, Dr. W. D. Rankine of Woodstock, C. D. Richards, M. P. P. and Professor Cameron.
