FIRST EDITION. IN A LONELY GRAVE.

MURDERED BODY OF JOHN WHALEN FOUND. Most brutal murder in a Berkshire Village—William Coy Under Arrest for the Crime—Blood on the Wall—Whale Found in His Pocket—Two Possible Suspects for the Fatal Blow.

At 10 o'clock this morning, a body was found in a lonely grave in the little town of Washington, on the line of the Boston & Albany railroad, about 12 miles east of St. John. John Whalen's body was discovered buried in a lonely wood half a mile south of the railroad.

Medical Examiner Paddock made an examination of the body, and found that the skull had been broken in a tremendous blow, as pieces of the skull were driven into the brain.

Whalen was 30 years old, and a single man. During the present summer he boarded with Coy and his wife at Washington, and worked on the Boston & Albany railroad as a track hand.

Whalen was last seen at Washington on the night of August 29, about 8 o'clock, in company with Coy. This is the story told by some of the Washington people.

The starting evidence developed today that Whalen was murdered in Coy's house, probably after he had gone to bed. The theory is so far as the evidence goes to show that when Coy went to Pittsfield, Whalen went home to Coy's house.
