Montreal, Oct. 27.—The steamship Lake Champlain which ran aground this morning, while leaving port, still remained stuck fast tonight in the south side of the channel opposite Laurier Pier. Eight tugs worked all day in an endeavor to pull her off, but in the face of the swift current, the effort proved useless. The cargo will have to be lighter-ed before the vessel can proceed. It is not thought that she is seriously injured. Forty-five first class passengers were 210 second class passengers were taken off the stranded vessel today by the C. P. R. tug Cruiser and trans-ferred to the Allan liner Grampian, sailing for Glasgow tomorrow.
