For year ending December 31st, 1882.

In presenting our Annual Report for 1882, it is our pleasing duty to announce steady progress in almost every respect, and to acknowledge our deep sense of gratitude to God for the many blessings bestowed on us during the past year.

Our School was closed during the months of July and August, as it was found on inquiry that the majority of Teachers and Scholars would be absent from the city during that period.

The attendance has been very well maintained, and shows a slight increase over that of last year, the average number present being :—Teachers and Officers, 23 ; Scholars and Bible Classes, 131 ; and the numbers on roll at present ; Teachers and Officers, 28 ; Scholars and Bible Classes, 196 We have now great hopes of the success of the coming year, as the attendance of the past two months has exceeded that of any previous year of our history.

Our Missionary Collections on the whole have been very good, as will be shown by the Treasurer's statement, but we regret to observe that the interest in the Children's Missionary Society appears to be lessening, and we would recommend that some change be made in the carrying on of this important branch of Sunday School work.

The Library is still in good form, and continues to supply the Scholars with abundance of good and
