LOWER OPENINGS AND WORKING LOWER — CORN INCLINES

Chicago, Feb. 8.

Yesterday closing price at Liverpool was the lowest for a week. It was 5-10½ for March, whereas it was 5-11 on the 10th January, May wheat 5-0¾ was also lower.

New York opening for March at 74½ was ¾ lower than the closing bid yesterday; July at 74½ was ¼ lower, but the early market if inactive was working higher.

Wheat was also ¾ lower at Chicago. It rallied the first half hour, but failed to reach the opening price before it fell off again. Anticipations were that it, wheat, might go lower.

Provision market was little else than a repetition of the grain market. Its openings were some cents lower, its early movements were rallied, but after the first half hour sank back to the prices at which they started.
