

# MONTREAL LIGHT INFANTRY.

## REGULATIONS,

---

*Submitted, 6th December, 1856, for sanction of His Excellency the Commander in Chief; and sanctioned, 18th December, 1856.*

---

1.—The *Corps* will consist of six Companies, each of 75 Men, <sup>Strength of</sup> besides a Bugler, and due complement of Officers and Non-<sub>*Corps.*</sub> commissioned Officers.

2.—It will be the duty of each Captain of a Company, aided <sup>How to be re-</sup> by his Subalterns and Non-commissioned Officers, to raise his <sub>recruited.</sub> Company, and keep it at its proper strength.

3.—The standard of height for Recruits will be five feet six inches, and every Recruit, before his enrolment shall take effect, must have been approved by the Commanding Officer of the *Corps*, on report of the Sergeant Major, confirmed (if there be any doubt as to health or habits) by the Surgeon or Assistant Surgeon.

4.—Any Non-commissioned Officer, Private or Bugler, desiring <sup>Discharge</sup> to leave the *Corps*, will be required to give at least one month's <sub>therefrom.</sub> notice of such wish, with a good and sufficient reason therefor, in order to entitle him to his discharge.

5.—Until such time as the organization of the *Corps* shall have <sup>Provisional En-</sup> been completed, by the final enrolment of its full strength, it shall <sub>rolment.</sub> be competent for the Commanding Officer to allow such part of the strength of each Company as he may deem requisite, to be provisionally enrolled.

6.—Men provisionally enrolled will be liable to be replaced at any time by Recruits offering for final enrolment, subject only to a right of preference (if they themselves shall offer) for final enrolment.
