

then the Speaker sits not in the Chair as Speaker.

XXVII.

From Committee of the Whole, how the House shall be resumed. That when the House shall be put into a Committee of the Whole House, the House be not resumed without the unanimous consent of the Committee, unless upon a Question put by the Member who shall be in the Chair of such Committee.

XXVIII.

What Rules apply to a Committee of the Whole. That in Committee of the Whole House the Rules of the House shall be observed, in so far as they may be applicable, excepting the Rule limiting the times of speaking; and that no Motion for the Previous Question, or for Adjournment, can be received; but a Member may at any time move that the Chairman do leave the Chair, or to report some progress made, and ask leave to sit again.
