fengers to or from the Fishery at Newfoundland, etc.

shall be demanded out of any Port or Place of the United Kingdom, carrying Passengers to the Island of Newfoundland, or to the Coast of Labrador, or to the Banks of Newfoundland, to be employed in the Trade or Fishery thereof, or returning from the said Island of Newfoundland, the Coast of Labrador, or the Banks of Newfoundland, with Passengers who have been so employed; any Thing in the said Act to the contrary in anywise notwithstanding.
