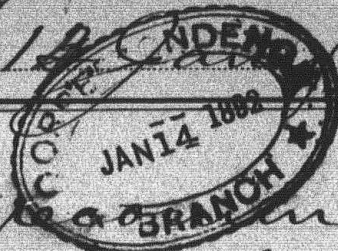

I beg to recommend that the plan or tracing of the Little Shuswap Lake Indian Reserves which accompanied Mr. O'Reilly's letter of the 23rd Nov be returned to him, and he be informed that, for future reference, it is desirable that the plan should have noted on its face, the date of survey, and the name of the surveyor.

Mr. O'Reilly's attention might also be drawn to the fact that there is a discrepancy of about 2 chains in the closing distance - 25.70 chs - on the western boundary of No. 14 reserve, as it scales about 27.50 chains -
