With reference to your letter of the
17th ult. relative to Nemlock Saw Logs cut under
License by M. Mc. St. Denis, on Indian Land
in the Township of Newburg. I have to inform
you that as for ordinary uses, Nemlock is per-
haps desirable than Pine that instead of 32 Cents
per Standard Log of 21 inches diameter equal
to 81.00 per 1000 ft. inch board measure, 20 Cents
per Standard Log, may be a suitable change.

Sir

I have to call your attention to the
instructions conveyed to you by the letter of the 13 of
last month relative to money collected as Rents and
other Summs derived from the Indian lands in
the vicinity of St. Louis. You will please to un-
derstand that all such monies are to be deposited
in the Bank of Montreal to the credit
of the Hon. the Receiver General in acct. of Indian
funds within the month in which they are paid,
and the deposit certificates are to be forwarded
by you to this Office accompanied by a monthly
return showing the names of the Parties from whom
the monies have been received. The Lands, Timber
or other amounts in connection with which payment
has

has been made, and in case of Rent the period within
the payment comes. I have not observed that any return
of the past month has been received and take this oppor-
tunity for pointing out to you that the periodical returns
of that nature should be sent in as regularly as possible
after the close of each month.
