I beg to inform you that the Department is advised by Mr Carter, Indian Superintendent, at Richibucto, of the death of Dr E. Moore, of Salisbury, who for some years past rendered medical attendance to the Indians of that district. Mr Carter has also forwarded a letter from Dr N.A. Jones, of the same place, asking to be allowed to render such services as are required. There is no salary attached to the position. Dr Moore was paid on accounts rendered for such services as were actually required by the Indians from time to time.
