Reverend Sir,

I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 30th ult., in reference to the forwarding of applications for admission to the Shingwauk Home. In reply I beg to say that the Department realized the difficulties that you meet with in having these applications and medical certificates made out and forwarded. I would advise however, to have them transmitted to the Department in proper form in each case, with as little delay as possible. Full payment will be made for children from the time they enter the school.

In regard to transport, I may say the Department does not assume any obligation unless in cases where they commit children to the school under the regulations.

The applications for the admission of Leslie Isaac and Philip George are approved.
