Sir,-

I am in receipt of your letter of the 3rd instant, relative to medical attendance in the case of John Sunday; and in reply I beg to say that the explanations which you have furnished are satisfactory. The Department approves of the action of the Chief in insisting upon the Indians of the Alnwick Band calling upon Dr. Brown, unless they are prepared to pay for a physician's services. You should give the doctors resident in the vicinity of the reserve to understand that Dr. Brown is the salaried attendant to Indians, and that if other doctors attend the Indians, they will have to look to the Indians for settlement of accounts for services rendered.
