
Ottawa, September 21st, 1936.

Dear Sir,-

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of August 31st last, No. 197-A-4, advising that the Nanaimo-Duncan Utilities, Limited, had paid the sum of \$5.00, under authority of the Chief, to erect a power pole on the edge of the Nanaimo Indian Reserve No. 1 on the street allowance.

In reply I may say that the Chief has no authority to grant such permission and I would ask you to be good enough to bring the matter before the Band for consideration, in order that the necessary action may be taken by them. You will then forward the resolution to the Department in the usual way.
