12. Even if the present ceilings were raised as above, it is not expected that the flow of recruits would be substantially increased. This action, however, would enable the three Services to continue to accept a large proportion of otherwise qualified applicants having educational qualifications down to Grade IX, and even in some cases below, without interfering with their planned programmes.
