of the enforcement of the regulations until October 1st to make it possible to salvage something out of the present tourist season. At that time you should also inform Mr. Hull that if the United States regulations should, are not altered or postponed, we plan to the an inexpensive passport or travel document, valid only for the United States and for a term of one year, which will make it possible for Ganadians to visit the United States without having imposed upon them an undue financial You should add that if the Canadian Government find it burden. necessary to impose passport and visa regulations upon United States citizens visiting Canada we would strongly urge upon the United States Government consideration of the possibility of substituting for its present expensive passport a travel document of a somewhat similar character which would prove less of parrier for United States citizens of moderate means who may wish to visit the Dominion.

6. Will you please emphasize to the Secretary of State that a very early decision would be greatly appreciated.
