- (a) On page A the hour of trial should be shown as 2 P.M. ✓
- (b) On page B, deletions and insertions were not all initialled. ✓
- (c) In the Charge Sheet the statement of the offence should be set forth in capital letters and the change of hour of apprehension was not initialled. ✓
- (d) On page C no mention was made of the exhibits being read to the accused on presentation. ✓
- (e) On page C the insertion of the word "states" was not initialled. ✓
- (f) Rule of Procedure 83(B) should have been complied with in all cases as no shorthand writer was employed. ✓
- (g) At the conclusion of the evidence for the Prosecution the statement should have been made that there were no further witnesses for the Prosecution. ✓
- (h) On page D7, the Court should not question the accused in order to help the Prosecution. Question 45 should not have been asked by the Court, although in this case it has not prejudiced the accused. ✓
- (i) It would have been advisable for the Prosecution to produce Bdr Preston to set forth his incidental expenses while on duty as escort in order to justify Exhibit K. ✓
- (j) Appendix N was not signed by the President. ✓
- (k) It does not appear how the Court in their special finding arrived at the 22nd March, 1942, as the date of commencement of illegal absence. ✓
- (l) The deletion "is duly" on page E was not initialled. ✓
- (m) In M.F.B.355 the schedule should not have been ruled out completely, but should have been filled in with the name of the accused and use made of the word "nil." ✓

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
