

Third Witness: Lt J B Smith, ^{see} X # 4 MC,
 89 Borden Hosp., Evans. Date ^{of deposition} 9/24/41
 I first saw this patient 9/24/41 at 0200 hrs when he was brought
 into a hospital with a history of
 having been beaten up by military
 police. When seen he was semi-
 conscious but could be roused
 and talked quite intelligently.
 The face was grossly bruised
 on both sides. He was bleeding
 profusely from the nose and had
 a small laceration on the left
 eyebrow. There were no other
 apparent injuries. He was ad-
 mitted to hospital and x-rays
 taken. X-rays revealed fracture
 of the nose and fracture of
 base of skull in the anterior
 fossa. The injuries are con-
 sistent with being beaten
 with the fists on the face
 and striking his head on
 the floor as he said he
 did when being beaten.

The accused declines to exam-
 ine this witness.
