- (4) "a bridge across Lillooet river." (assistance.)
- (5) "a wagon road to Glacier Lake reserve." (assistance.)
- (6) "Monthly rations." (This is obscure. Practically all the Indians are against taking rations as compensation. It may mean monthly help to the aged or indigent J.A.T.)
- (7) "We want liberty to catch fish for food all the year around. Hunt small & big game & trap fur bearing animals in season in any unoccupied part of B.C."
