We send them down to the Mission, at Mission City. There are about two there. The Indians here are poer, they cannot afford to send their children far away. Would they like to have a day school on the reserve here? Q. We would like to have a school here if we could get ite A. If a school were established here would you undertake to Q. see that the children attended regularly every day? It would be better if we had a boarding school here. Are there any children going to the Mission school new? R. One or two from this village go there now. Lets of more A children belonging to this band would go to a school if we had a school here. Is there a church here? Q. Yes. And does the missionary come to see you? Q. He comes once in a while. Qe What religion do the Indians belong to? All the Indians belong to the Catholic olm roh. On No. 2 A. there is a church which belongs to the English church, and on No. 1 it belongs to the Cathelies. How often does the priest come to see you? Q. Three or four times a year. Where from? Q. Mission City. Is there a missionary for the church on No. 2 - the Eng-Q. lish church? Sometimes he comes once a year and sometimes twice. A. Have you any doctor that comes to see you here? Q. (BY Agent Graham); We there is no regularly appointed doctor, although they have the privilege of going to the railway dector, who charges it up to the Dominione Q. Is there a doctor at Lillocat? Yes, we used to get the doctor from the Government, and I guess he got paid from the Dominion, but he charged us every

time we went to see him,
