CHURCH OF ENGLAND.

PROVINCE OF RUPERT'S LAND.

In 1820 the Rev. J. West came out from England as Chaplain to the Hudson's Bay Co. One of his first works was the erection of a rude school house at St. Johns, where he commenced to educate a few children. This building served also for a church. Mr. West only remained in the country three years. He was succeeded in 1823 by the Rev. P. Jones, as chaplain of the Company. The Ven. Archdeacon Cochrane came in 1825, and commenced his long ministerial service of 40 years in the country, in the chapel erected by Rev. Mr. West. After a time the wood building was replaced by a stone building, which was known as the Upper Church, and in 1862 this in turn, was replaced by the present St. John's Cathedral.
